WHEREAS, Mary Geegan Middleton has been building health care muscle in Cass County and Niles, Michigan for 40 years; and

WHEREAS, Mary is a graduate of Dowagiac High School, Southwest Michigan College and Ferris State University; and

WHEREAS, Mary began her career in health care at Four Flags Health Ventures in Niles and began at Cass Medical Clinic on School Street in Cassopolis, painting and papering and making sure the clinic ran smoothly; and

WHEREAS, in 2004 the clinic became the Cass Family Clinic and in 2005 became a Federally Qualified Health Center Look-Alike; and

WHEREAS, Mary has recently received the Liberty Bell Award from the Cass County Bar Association and was honored at the clinic for her 40 years of health care initiatives.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Cass County Board of Commissioners congratulate and thanks Mary Geegan Middleton for her 40 years of caring for our community and for providing them with medical care, dental care, and behavioral care and wishes her continued success in her life as she seeks to further health care here in Southwest Michigan.

Commissioner Marchetti moved, seconded by Commissioner Laylin, to approve the following resolution:

**REQUESTING STATE OF MICHIGAN FULFILLS ITS
STATUTORY OBLIGATION WITH REGARD TO STATE
REVENUE SHARING PAYMENTS**

WHEREAS, in 2004 an agreement was made between the State of Michigan and the counties that eliminated county revenue sharing payments for a period of time during which counties were allowed to pay themselves an equivalent amount to their statutory revenue sharing payments. Each proceeding year the Michigan Department of Treasury authorized each county an inflationary increase over the base amount established in 2004; and

WHEREAS, this agreement saved the State of Michigan from allocating general fund dollars by funding the County Revenue Sharing Reserve Fund (CRSRF) through a property tax collection shift. However, once a county exhausted their reserve fund, they were to re-enter the state revenue sharing system. By statute, the State was required to allocate the county their full revenue sharing amount when they re-entered the system. Full-funding is defined as the 2004 base amount plus inflation until the county re-entered the system; and

WHEREAS, counties that re-entered the state revenue sharing system prior to 2014 endured cuts to their base revenue sharing payments that were never restored. Counties that re-entered the system after 2014 did not endure the same cuts to their base revenue sharing payments; and

WHEREAS, the Michigan Association of Counties has identified 61 counties that endured cuts to their base revenue sharing payments, which together accounts for a cumulative shortfall in revenue sharing payments to the counties of \$117,617,804; and

WHEREAS, Cass County re-entered the state revenue sharing system in 2011 and is owed \$717,466 from the State of Michigan; and

WHEREAS, the State of Michigan may question the necessity of making these payments to the counties now in light of the counties slated to receive COVID-19 funding from the American Rescue Plan; however, those funds are tied to a number of restrictions on how the money can be used. County revenue sharing payments is unrestricted and can be used as necessary.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Cass County Board of Commissioners calls upon the State of Michigan to fulfill its statutory obligation to the counties that were shorted on their county revenue sharing payments.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be sent to Representative Steve Carra, State Representative Brad Paquette, Senator Kim LaSata, Governor Gretchen Whitmer, the Michigan Association of Counties, and to each county in the State of Michigan.

- WHEREAS,** the County Board of Commissioners has the authority to levy a maximum of 6.7531 mills, which includes 4.5909 allocated mills, 0.9903 mills for Council on Aging, 0.1979 mills for E911 Services, 0.4773 allocated mills for Drug Enforcement, and 0.4967 mills for Cass County Medical Care Facility and;
- WHEREAS,** the county can levy the full millage rate of 6.7531 only after fulfilling the public requirements of M.C.L. Section 211.34d and P.A. 5 of 1982 and;
- WHEREAS,** the Cass County Board of Commissioners has fulfilled the requirements of M.C.L. 211.34d and P.A. 5 of 1982.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that after much deliberation and consideration of the county's budgetary needs for 2021, the Cass County Board of Commissioners has decided, in the best interest of the county, to levy 6.7531 mills, which is 4.5909 allocated mills, 0.9903 mills for Council on Aging, 0.1979 mills for E-911 Services, 0.4773 mills for Drug Enforcement and 0.4967 mills for Cass County Medical Care Facility.

**CASS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
ACT 152 COMPLIANCE**

WHEREAS, 2011 Public Act 152 (the “Act”) was passed by the State Legislature and signed by the Governor on September 24, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Act contains three options for complying with the requirements of the Act; and

WHEREAS, the three options are as follows:

- 1) Section 3 - “Hard Caps” Option - limits a public employer’s total annual health care costs for employees based on coverage levels, as defined in the Act;
- 2) Section 4 – “80%/20%” Option – limits a public employer’s share of total annual health care costs to not more than 80%. This option requires an annual majority vote of the governing body;
- 3) Section 8 – “Exemption” Option – a local unit of government, as defined in the Act, may exempt itself from the requirements of the Act by an annual 2/3 vote of the governing body;

WHEREAS, the Cass County has decided to adopt the 80%/20% option as its choice of compliance under the Act.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Cass County Board of Commissioners elects to comply with the requirements of 2011 Public Act 152, the Publicly Funded Health Insurance Contribution Act, by adopting the 80%/20% option for the medical benefit plan coverage year September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2022.

WHEREAS, some industry changes were positive during the coronavirus and made sense; this change does not as constituents need to be able to transfer vehicles, renew and update driver’s licenses expediently, so that they can prove and provide legal ownership and residency; and

WHEREAS, these changes have been established without input from constituents, who are directly affected by this sweeping change and web-based services do not completely replace the need for walk in service at the branch offices. Many older residents and those without computers or internet will simply be turned away at the Secretary of State door; and

WHEREAS, these changes will only continue to frustrate citizens who just would like their license renewed or to be able to sell a vehicle, without having to wait weeks or even months or drive to a different service area to accomplish these simple tasks.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Cass County Board of Commissioners hereby **STRONGLY** opposes ‘By Appointment Only’ services for the residents not only in Cass County but for the entire State of Michigan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to Governor Gretchen Whitmer, Secretary of State Jocelyn Benson, Senate and House leaders, and Michigan Association of Counties.
